

IACC: Use of Member Images Policy

Images Alberta Camera Club (IACC) respects its members' copyright of their images (their intellectual property) and will do its utmost to protect it.

We commit to crediting the photographer whenever we display an image at a club event or on the club's website.

The digital version of winning competition entries will be kept indefinitely and used in IACC's activities (e.g., for promotional materials, publications, website and showing at club functions and tradeshow). Members who have submitted such images will retain copyright and will be credited for the images. If IACC wishes to use a member's image that has not been submitted for a competition, IACC will seek their permission. Non-winning entries will be deleted at the end of each year. IACC will honour requests to delete specific images.

Members submitting images for competitions (both in-club and club CAPA competitions) should be aware that competition entries will be displayed on IACC's website, where they can be seen by the public, as will all winning entries (along with the name of the photographer). These will be displayed at low resolution and with the download option disabled but note that IACC cannot prevent people from screen-capturing them.

Photographs shared with the host of a virtual meeting, workshop, or SIG meeting (for displaying them) will not be used for any other purpose and will be deleted immediately following the event.

Outing locations occasionally request copies of photographs captured during the specific outings. These requests will come through the Outing Chair, and the participating members may or may not choose to share their photographs. The member will retain the copyright of the shared photographs.
