

Permitted and Not Permitted AI Tools

For Use in IACC and CAPA Competitions

The list is extensive. Please make sure that you are reading the entry for the correct software, and for the correct version of that software!

The list is evolving. New features and new tools will result in updates. **Check back from time to time** to keep up with the changes for your particular software and use cases.

CAPA has extensive protocols for detecting forbidden tools. This involves both human checkers and detection software. Enforcement is strict for all their competitions.

The IACC uses the same list **for competitive categories** (100, 200, 300, Annual). The rules for Exhibition/Showcase monthly categories (600, 700) are much more permissive in regards to AI. See the Competition Manual. If in doubt, ask the [Competition Chair](#).
