- 4) Ukrainian Orthodox Church, Andrew (32 km., 22 minutes from last)
- 5) Spaca Moskalyk Ukrainian Catholic Church, northeast of Mundare on Range Road 160. The church is being re-built. (37 km., 26 minutes from last)
- 6) Ukrainian Orthodox Church of the Dominion of St. Mary Sich Kolomea, on Range Road 540 (2.2 km., 2 minutes from last)
- 7) Back to Tim Horton's in Fort Saskatchewan (79 km., 54 minutes from last).
